VINEYARD

24 acres located between the cool Russian River , the warm Alexander Valley and Knights Valley.

HARVEST

Organic farming
Rainwater harvesting and only twice irrigations per year

VINIFICATION

Small lot fermentation in thermo regulated stainless steel tanks. 4 days of cold soak followed by alcoholic fermentation. The malo-lactic fermentation follows in barrel.

TASTING NOTES

The nose gathers some fresh red current while preserving a rich, deep color. On the palate, there is a balance between freshness and power. Voluptuous and smooth with finely textured tannins, a medium to full-bodied mouth feel and a long finish with undertones of vanilla subtly brought by the fine toasted oak.

ABOUT THE WINEMAKER

This property was purchased in 2011 by Claire & Gonzague Lurton, prestigious Owners & Winemakers of two Grand Cru Classé Châteaux in Margaux and Pauillac. Acaibo is a very special wine to us as it represents the first vintage of our new endeavor here in California. Coming on the heels of two rather tough years, this vintage proved to be spectacular. The grapes on our estate enjoyed a long hang time with warm days and cool nights that led to a mid October pick. Acaibo: a proud blend of our French tradition with a very American spirit of adventure.
